While every effort is made to clear bulk refuse promptly, the problem can only be solved by a close partnership between the council and its residents. The cost of removing bulk refuse is recovered from residents through rents and service charges.

We need your help to let us know the details of residents who dump furniture, addresses of properties where builders leave their rubbish or students discard their belongings when they move on.



**We need your help** to provide the registration numbers of vehicles dumping waste. We will follow up with the strongest possible enforcement action. Fly tipping is a criminal offence and the council will crack down on those who deface the estate in this way.
