Coronavirus Update

With the rapidly evolving situation around Covid-19, we are aware that many organisations in receipt of grant funding have planned large scale events or workshops planned over the next few months, utilising funds from Wandsworth Grants Fund.

We want to reassure you that should any changes be required, based on Government public Health advice, that within the written agreement there is scope for the terms to be varied, which could include the end period being extended. We also recognise that for some organisations they may wish to reprioritise their work to respond to Covid-19, which we would welcome where it assists local people.

We would ask that you keep in touch about future plans so that we can keep track of any funds and planned activities to ensure that they are utilised in the best possible way.

The Council also has emergency funding available where projects such as those with a community focus around Covid-19, sit outside the current Wandsworth Grants Fund timeline and framework, and it is looking to do something community focus around COVID-19 then they could apply.
