

Driving our sustainable transport transition.

Over 560 EV charging points in the borough and another 140 lampost sockets on the way with further installations planned in 2021.

5,000 plug-in vehicles registered in Wandsworth with numbers rising by more than ten per cent every three months.

Highest take-up rate of car club membership in the country with more than 31,000 registered members.
