## Night-time Only: Carriageway Resurfacing - Putney High Street

Following the completion of the traffic signal upgrades on Putney High Street, the final element of construction work is to resurface the carriageway. The works are programmed to take place from 24 February 2025 to 4th March 2025 between the junctions of Felsham Road, Putney Bridge Road, Lower Richmond Road and the initial section of Putney Bridge. Following the resurfacing works the installation of traffic signal detection equipment can be installed in the road. This detection equipment will enable the traffic lights to be remotely optimised by Transport for London (TfL), so that the traffic flows across the two junctions run as smoothly as possible.

Due to the traffic sensitive nature of the area, we'll be completing the works at night, to reduce the impact on people using the road. Works will generally take place between the hours of 21:00hrs and 05:00hrs.

Roads will be closed one section at a time with through traffic diversions in place. It will be necessary to close side roads adjacent to the resurfacing area, and they will temporarily have two way access for local access only with parking suspensions to enable turn around areas and passing places. The existing road closure on Felsham Road will be opened temporarily to maintain access.

## The outline programme by night shift:

24/02/25 - Putney Bridge and Lower Richmond Road junction

25/02/25 - Lower Richmond Road Putney Embankment to Putney Bridge

26/02/25 - Putney High Street northbound - Putney Bridge to Putney Bridge Road

27/02/25 - Putney High Street southbound - Putney Bridge to Putney Bridge Road

28/02/25 - Putney Bridge Road - Brewhouse Lane to Putney High Street

03/03/25 - Putney High Street southbound - Putney Bridge to Felsham Road

04/03/25 – Completion of lining and signal loop detection
