Free bulky waste collections – every household now gets two free bulky waste collections every year.

Safer neighbourhoods – we have a network of over 1,200 CCTV cameras to monitor the borough 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Half-price tickets for events such as Battersea Park Fireworks, our pantomime and a range of arts and cultural events to celebrate our year as London Borough of Culture 2025



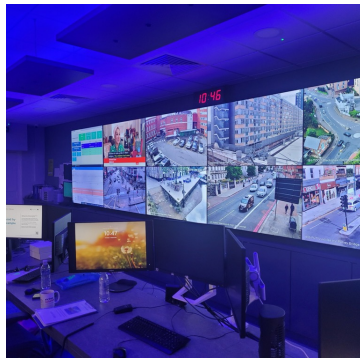


Community safety

Our state-of-the-art emergency control room is operational 365 days a year and manages a CCTV network of 1,200 cameras across the borough that is monitored by specialist staff during peak times.

The CCTV helps to:

- Prevent and detect crime, working with police to address ASB and the safety of women and girls
- Tackle fly-tipping and graffiti
- Locate vulnerable people in public spaces
- Support emergency services during live incidents



Transport investment keeps the borough moving

Improving your roads

- Over the next year we will invest over £10 million to repair and renew pavements and to resurface many of our roads
- We will also replace damaged street signs and repaint road markings
- As part of our vision to make Wandsworth fairer, we're using funds collected from property developers for these improvements

Safer School Streets

- Over half of primary schools now participate in our School Streets programme
- By restricting traffic during school pick up and drop off times, there is less congestion, cleaner air, and safer routes for our children

More bike hangars

- We have London's biggest bike hangar programme, with 120 new hangars being installed
