




What is it?

- Developers must pay funds known as the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) to local councils as part of their planning commitments on certain types of new development.
- NCIL is a portion of these funds, which are reinvested back into our communities to address neighbourhood priorities and provide community solutions.
- As development increases there will be a greater demand placed on Infrastructure e.g. community facilities, green spaces, sustainable transport
- In Wandsworth the NCIL funding is called Neighbourhood Renewal Fund.
