Dear Residents and Stakeholders,

We would like to continue to apologies for any inconvenience caused over the last period.

Phase I, like all projects when working through the completions & handover it's been an extremely busy period, however we are pleased to inform you that most of the new home-owners have moved into the 3 main apartment blocks A,B & C, and that works to Blocks D, F & E are currently targeted to complete Spring 25, with the final 6 houses in blocks G & H completing late Summer 25.

Phase 2 works for the NHS are now progressing well and are estimated to be completed by Autumn 25, when Brocklebank will decant and move into the new center.



#### **On Site Activities**

#### **PHASE I:**

### Block D (8 x apartments):

- · Utility connections have now been finalized.
- The new external brickwork walls have been completed and preparation for the paving is currently being undertaken.
- The fit out of the units is now progressing to different stages, from electrical and plumbing works to decorations.

#### Block E & F. (15 x houses):

- Block E & F, external works are coming to a completion and await the final utility connection via Thames Water.
- The internal fit out of the units are progressing at different stages and the first plot in block F, is being prepared for the new home-owner to move in before Christmas.

#### PHASE I

#### Blocks G & H (9 x houses):

- Block G, plot I is now occupied, plot 2 continues to be used as a Show House and the remaining 4 plots have been fitted with a scaffolding roof and are currently having their roofs fitted.
- Internal fit off these units is planned to commence in early next year.
- Block H, The external façades have been completed and roofing is currently being undertaken, which is planned to be completed by the end of this year.



#### PHASE 2:

#### **Health Centre ph2a:**

- The external scaffolding has been completed and wrapped in plastic sheeting.
- Works to the façade are currently being undertaken, brick & stonework are progressing up to the first floor.
- The NHS fit out works have recently started and are underway, with the new stud partition wall currently being erected.

#### New Affordable Rent Apartments ph2b;

Following the granting of planning permission, the
design team have been engaged and have started the
complex design, once concluded it will be submitted
to new government building control body for their
approval and sign off, the team is currently planning to
have this process completed by Mid 2026.





#### **SITE LOGISTICS:**

Steve our Logistic Manager and his team, work to ensure that no deliveries are made during the school drop off and pick up time slots and ensure that there is always a presents in on the surrounding roads.

- Although deliveries for ph I have eased off, there are unfortunately still a few utilities connection which still need to be undertaken, the permits and permissions for these works are put together directly between the utilities & LBW highways, however Steve will always be part of the process.
- Due to the location of ph2, corner of Garratt Lane & Swaffeild Rd the council have not permitted any delivery/off-loading zone on either of these roads & have insisted that all deliveries are made via Farlton, Atheldene & Oakshaw Roads.

#### New Pavement works:

 Now that most of the works on phase I are coming to a completion, a programme of works is currently being drawn up with LBW highways team with a view to starting soon, these works will ensure that all of the pavements adjacent to the new building will be lifted and relayed, bringing them back to the same standard they were before the development started.
