

I have reviewed the Putney Society's comment, attached, which still applies.

But given the change in the economic and development climate since the original consultation, I think that someone should ask the Inspector if the proposed changes to the Local Plan are still 'in accord' with the London Plan when it has been widely reported recently that the GLA is likely to revise its affordable housing percentage downwards.

We would also question whether the proposed revised policies are 'effective' if the aim is to provide more affordable homes when the current level of contribution is already damaging the viability of development.
