The statement of decisions will, therefore, in most cases, refer to the reports as the source of any alternative options considered and the reasons for decisions once the recommendations are adopted. If the Executive go further than the recommendations in a report, and make additional decisions, whose justification is not covered in the report, it will be necessary for specific reasons to be stated at the time.
